MEDICAL APPROACH

Medical operations: Operations on site

During my first visit to Rwanda in 2023, I was confronted with cases of abuse and burns that required urgent action.

It was not due to the expertise of the specialists there, but to a lack of training, medical equipment and, in some cases, inadequate infrastructure. Thanks to digital media, I am already informed about upcoming cases in Germany and can prepare myself in a targeted manner.

Working closely with colleagues, I drew up treatment plans and procured the necessary materials.

Most of my operations involve children. Follow-up care can be coordinated from Germany, as images of the healing process are constantly exchanged.

The operations are carried out both in the university hospital in Kigali (Rwanda) and in a small district hospital in Gikonko (Rwanda), which is run by a German nun and surgeon.

I will also be performing similar operations in a small hospital in Kabanga (Tanzania). Incidentally, this hospital was built by the Kempten-based organisation "von Herz zu Herz e.V. – Hilfe die ankommt".

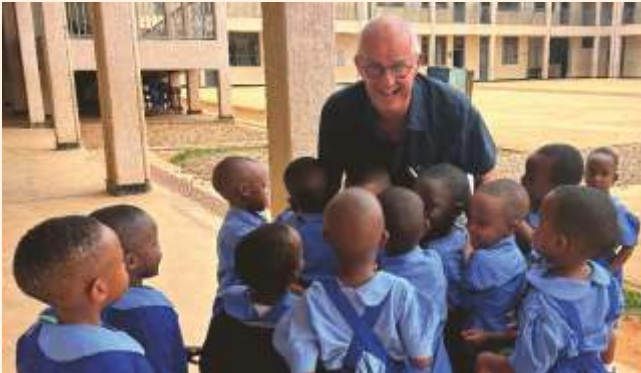




PROJECT 2025

Pallottine Sisters' School Kitchen & Refectory

To provide students at a school run by sisters of the Pallottine Order in the southeast of Rwanda's capital with a balanced meal every day, a much-needed school kitchen and dining hall were built. The project aims to ensure that 2,000 children can learn in good health and have better prospects for the future. The cornerstone was laid in July 2025.



The grand opening took place in April 2026, attended by many students, teachers, and representatives from the local and state governments.

Women's refuge "Handspun Hope"

The "Handspun Hope" women's shelter in Musanze provides shelter and a livelihood through work in the textile industry to approximately 200 women who have experienced violence or are living with HIV or hepatitis.

PROJECT 2026

Turning old into new – Homes for families in need

To enable low-income families to live in decent housing, we work together to build new homes.



The new homeowners do not receive the houses as a gift; instead, they contribute their own labour, within the limits of their abilities, to the construction and the various trades involved.

On site, Dr. Uta Düll (a local German surgeon and nun) works with the respective local committees to identify families in need.



The old houses are moldy, have crumbling walls, and leaky roofs.

The new houses are solidly built and equipped with a rainproof tin roof. In addition, the houses are equipped with a small photovoltaic system for generating electricity.

The furniture is made by local craftsmen, and a portable stove allows for cooking even outside the house.



The cement-reinforced mud bricks are made on site and left to dry in the sun. When rain threatens, the finished bricks are covered with tarps.

The cost of a complete house is €2,000.



PEDAGOGICAL APPROACH

Training and workshops for medical professionals



An essential component of a country's medical care is the high-quality training of doctors.

Only sound training can ensure that these countries are able to care for their population independently and without external support from abroad in the long term.

In order to promote this training, I therefore organise training events directly in Rwanda and Tanzania in consultation with the relevant institutions.

At these events, I give lectures to medical students and future specialists to provide them with valuable theoretical and practical knowledge. I also assist on site in the operating theatre, where my focus is not only

on supporting the surgical procedures, but above all on explaining the procedures in order to give the students a deep understanding of the medical processes.

All donations are deductible. To ensure that my work is transparent and verifiable, I have been appointed an auxiliary person of the Friends' Association and will report to the Friends' Association every six months.
